

## SOCIAL COMPETITIONS

The Glen ladies social competitions provide the ideal opportunity to bring together members, new and old, to enjoy nine holes of fun golf. The emphasis is on enjoyment, and is an ideal way for new members to meet fellow golfers, exchange contact details, and arrange future games.

Entering a competition can be a daunting task for many, but please be assured that our social competitions are fun, educational, and designed to promote confidence on the course. Many members have used the social competitions as a stepping stone to formal competitive golf ie friendly matches and medals.

The competitions are usually arranged in teams of three, each team containing at least one experienced golfer who can advise on the format, the rules of the competition and will keep the scorecard.

A handicap is not required but is preferable. Entrants who do not have a WHI handicap are provided with a maximum of 46.

The competitions are usually played over nine holes followed by a light meal in the clubhouse.

Social competitions are for golfers of all levels of experience and ability, and are the ideal way to forge new friendships within the Glen Golf Club.
