How to mark a card – General play (see item 5 for video example)

Note change in terminology on the app. Marker refers to the <u>tee markers</u> (red/yellow, etc). The person marking your card/verifying your score is the ATTESTER.

- Click on SCORECARDS
- Click on CREATE A SCORECARD

Click on SELECT A COURSE

New screen

Find a course – scroll down until you find relevant course and click on it. This will return you to previous page/screen with course name entered.

Click on SELECT MARKER

New screen

- ♣ Click on 18H or 9H at top of screen and then click on relevant tee marker colour
- Click on SAVE (on iPhone SAVE is replaced by CREATE SCORECARD)

New screen

The heading on this page is **ROUND SET UP**. It confirms the date, tees, recent scorecards. Player name is here and space to add playing partners. You have the choice either to record the score for just a single playing partner (in which case enter their name only) or to record scores for all players in your group. However, please note when the round is complete you can only attest ONE person's score.

- Click on SAVE
- ♣ Start marking score cards. There is a box with + or − (minus). Click plus and par for the hole will automatically appear in the box. Click plus or minus until it shows your actual score for the hole. Do the same for the player/players you are marking. Alternatively, you can click on the box and use keypad below to enter the score. Swipe left to move to next hole or use forward/back arrows.
- When round complete, click on **FINISH**. Your hole by hole score will appear for checking with the person marking your "card".
- **CONFIRM** score.

New screen

There is a signature box for you to sign. Below the signature box, there will be a box to type in the name of **ATTESTER** (i.e. person checking your score). **Only verify score for one playing partner** (between you agree whose card you are verifying and select that player as your

Attester). If their name does not appear automatically (e.g. if they were recording your score manually on a paper scorecard), you can search for their name by typing their SURNAME under relevant club. Select **ATTESTER**

- Click on SAVE.
- **CONFIRM AND SUBMIT SCORE**
